In celebration of the 30th Anniversary of Terry Fox's Marathon of Hope, help students carry on his legacy by guiding them in a discussion about their own dreams.

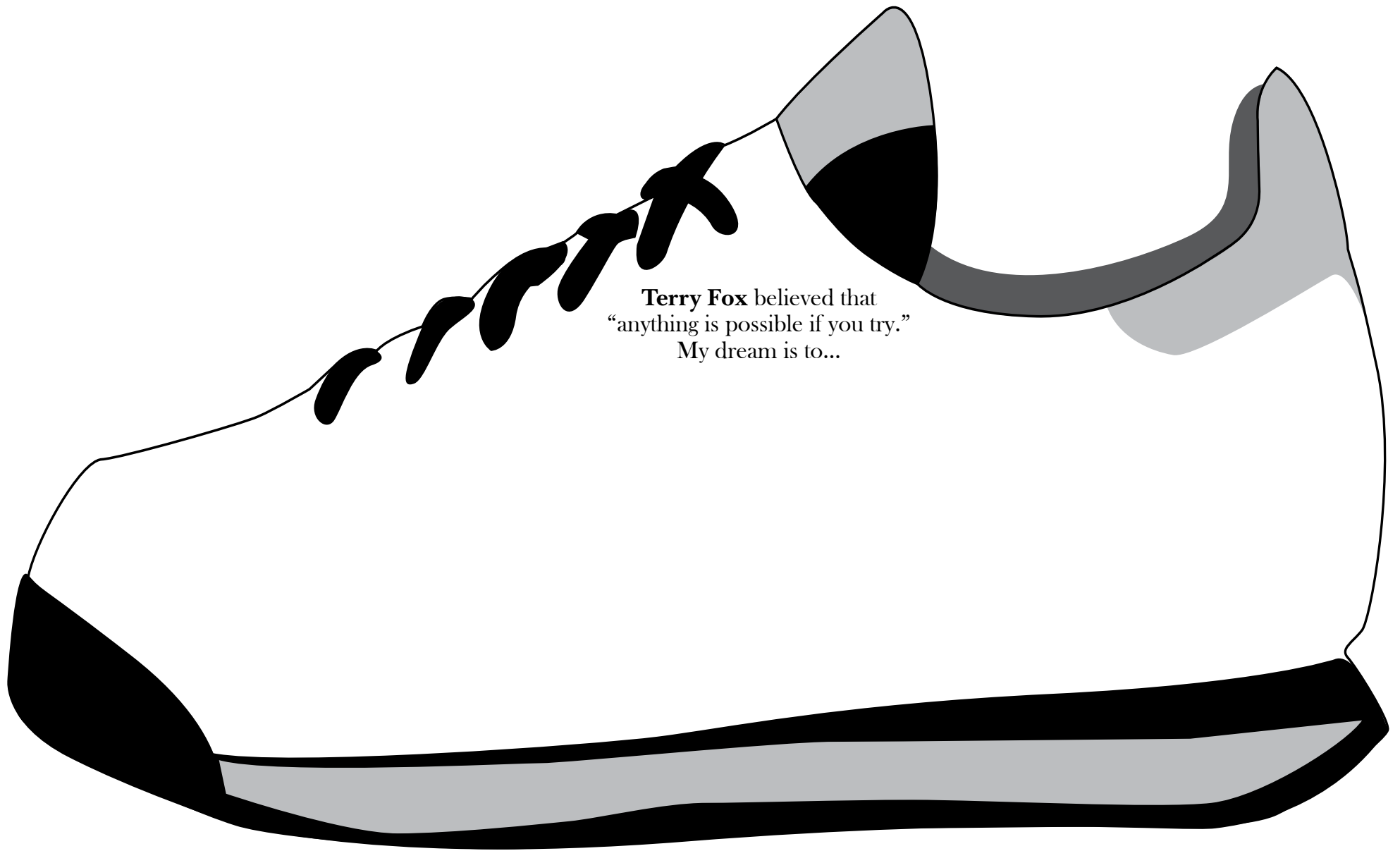
